- Column mounted jib cranes located over assembly and welding bays to aid in ergonomics.
- Multiple "Big Ass Fans" (20ft diameter each) to keep air moving during hot summer days.
- 150,000 lbs in the floor, flush mounted, scale to gather wheel loading data.

- Multi-story office building attached to manufacturing area..
- Every office has a window facing outside or into the manufacturing area.
- Oversized conference rooms located on each floor with windows looking into the plant.
